- Structure Fire -

LOMPOC, Ca., February 18, 2011 – At 3:49 am, Santa Barbara County Fire Department (SBC FD) responded to a two alarm structure fire, located at 1899 Mission Gate Drive, in Lompoc. SBC FD responded 7 engines, a water tender and two chief officers to the scene. SBC FD was assisted by Lompoc City Fire Department.



Firefighters responded when a passing motorist noticed the fire. A large, approximately 8000 square foot building, was well involved with fire when firefighters arrived on scene. The building was a combination office, residential, and storage. Firefighters conducted a primary search of the building. The structure was unoccupied. Firefighters made an aggressive interior attack and knocked the fire down at 4:20 am. There were no injuries reported. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

As of 6:am, firefighters remain on scene conducting salvage and overhaul operations.
