- Structure Fire -

SANTA YNEZ, Ca. December 5, 2011 – At 5:04 pm, the Santa Barbara County Fire Department (SBC FD) responded to a single family residential structure fire, located 2750 Baseline Ave. in Santa Ynez.

SBC FD responded 7 engines, water tender, a breathing support and a battalion chief. SBC FD was assisted by one engine from Santa Maria Fire Department and the California Highway Patrol. American Medical Response provided medical standby. Additional resources had to be moved from the Santa Barbara south county to cover the north county.

Firefighters arrived on scene and found the home fully involved. All residents escaped and were accounted for. Animal Rescue responded due to the resident's numerous birds and pets, however they were unharmed. Access to the home was restricted due to a narrow driveway. The fire was knocked down at 5:50 pm. CHP provided traffic control in the area.

Firefighters will remain on scene salvaging items from the home, checking for extension into the attack and overhauling the fire.

No other structures were threatened, there were no evacuations and there were no injuries reported. The cause of the fire is under investigation.
